What this is

Finishing and submitting are two different brain skills.

Why it shows up

- Working memory drops at the finish line
- Organizational handoff isn't automatic
- Stress spikes after effort is spent

What to try this week

1. Create **one single turn-in spot**
2. Add a visual or photo check before packing
3. End homework with the handoff step

When to get support

If missing work affects grades or self-esteem, systems must replace reminders.
